Standing Committees

The WTA-PTA currently has five standing committees. These standing committees function as general categories for similarly themed committees. The standing committee chair should be kept informed of committee activity to help aid the committees in achieving their functions, finding answers they may need and avoid scheduling or other conflicts.

Committees
